

Alaska Department of Labor and Workforce Development (ADOL) Announcement

Alaska Claims Release 3.1 FROI/SROI EDI Requirements Version 1.0 Available for Download!

This is a notice that ADOL is going to implement the IAIABC Claims EDI R3.1 for Claims effective 5/17/2021.

ADOL has posted the ADOL FROI/SROI EDI Requirements Version (v 1.0) (Revision Date: 7/7/2020, Implementation Date: 05/17/2021). The requirements are immediately available for download at http://adoledi.info/. You can find the updated tables under the "EDI Requirements" link on the left-hand side of the page.

Important Changes to Note for EDI Claims R3.1 that will become effective 5/17/2021:

- For Date of Injury on or after 5/17/2021, ADOL will no longer be accepting invalid Social Security Numbers per the Social Security Administration. An example of this would be SSNs beginning with 9.
- ADOL will no longer accept FROI 04, SROI 04, SROI PD, SROI FN, SROI VE, FROI CO and SROI CO.
- ADOL will not be using the *new* FROI and SROI UR (Update Report) but will continue to accept the *grandfathered* FROI and SROI UR (Upon Request) for paper claims with JCN < 201320000.
- Permanent Partial benefits should be reported as Benefit Type Code x40 Permanent Partial Un-Scheduled, instead of BTC x30 Permanent Partial Scheduled previously used.
- Other Benefit Type (OBT) Code Value 310 (Total Penalties) and 320 (Total Interest) will only be valid on legacy claims (pre-R3.1 Implementation) AND OBT Value 311 (Total Employee Penalties) and 321 (Total Employee Interest) will only be valid on non-legacy (on or after R3.1 Implementation) claims.
- A Payment Segment(s) will be required for the reporting of Lump Sum Payments or Settlements with MTC PY.
